- Explore the research behind leading change.

**Avoid Doing**

- Didactic teaching approaches.
- Non-strategic allocation of resources.
- Stereotyping generations in maintaining the status quo.

**Keep Doing**

- Developing capacity in teachers and leaders.

**Stop Doing**

- What we've always done.
- Non-strategic allocation of resources.
- Management only
- Maintaining the status quo.
