**Start Doing**

- Students design spaces
- External learning areas
- Staff PD
- Writeable classroom surfaces
- De-privatising practice
- Different types/styles of learning spaces
- Promote collaboration (both staff and students).

**Avoid Doing**

- Building solid internal walls
- Fixed furniture
- Bulky furniture
- Timetabling unsupportive staff in new learning spaces.

**Keep Doing**

- Students design spaces
- External learning areas
- Staff PD
- Writeable classroom surfaces
- De-privatising practice
- Different types/styles of learning spaces
- Promote collaboration (both staff and students).

**Stop Doing**

- Closing classroom doors
- Blocking windows
- Limiting subjects to specific areas
- Building classrooms all the same size and shape.
