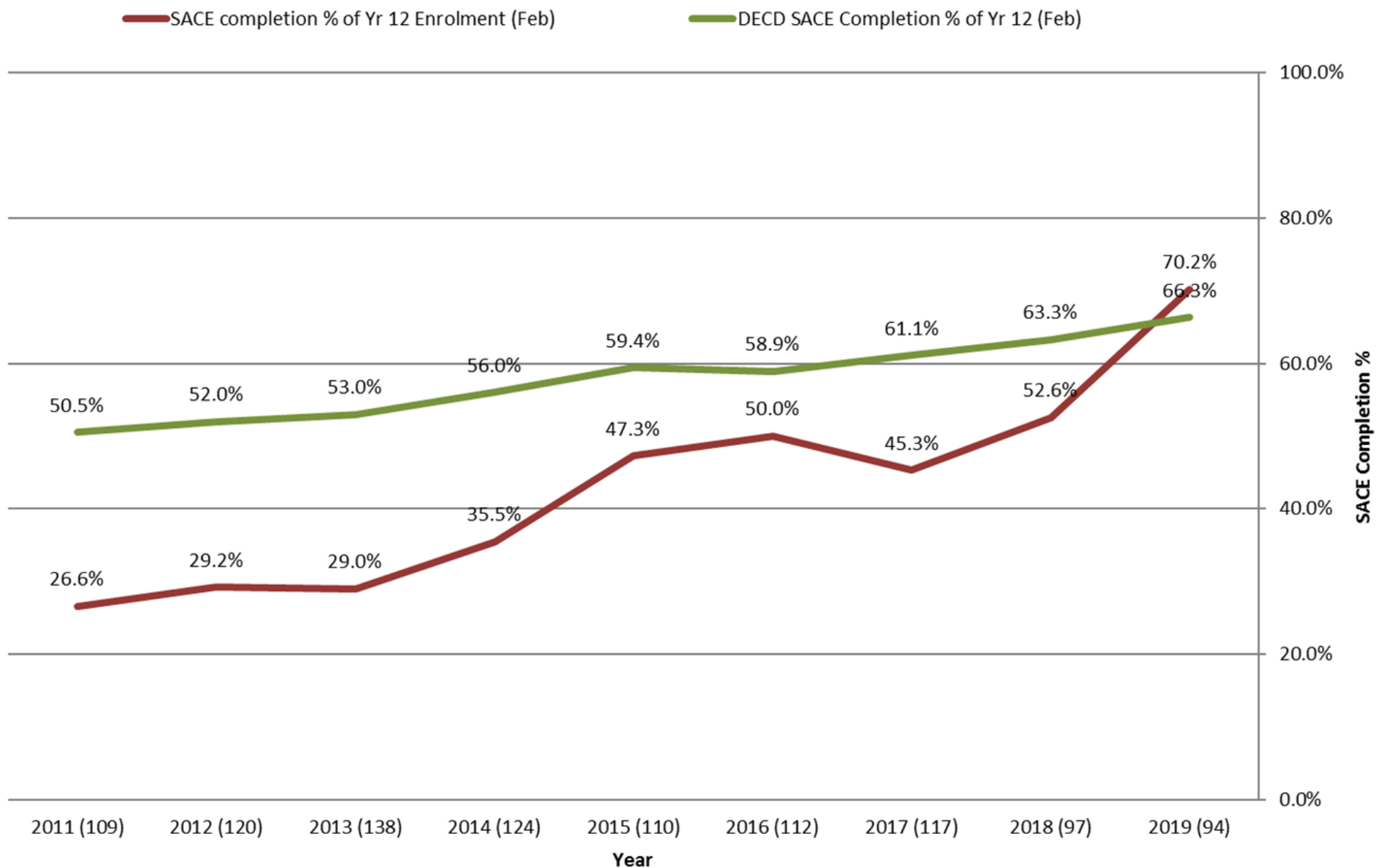

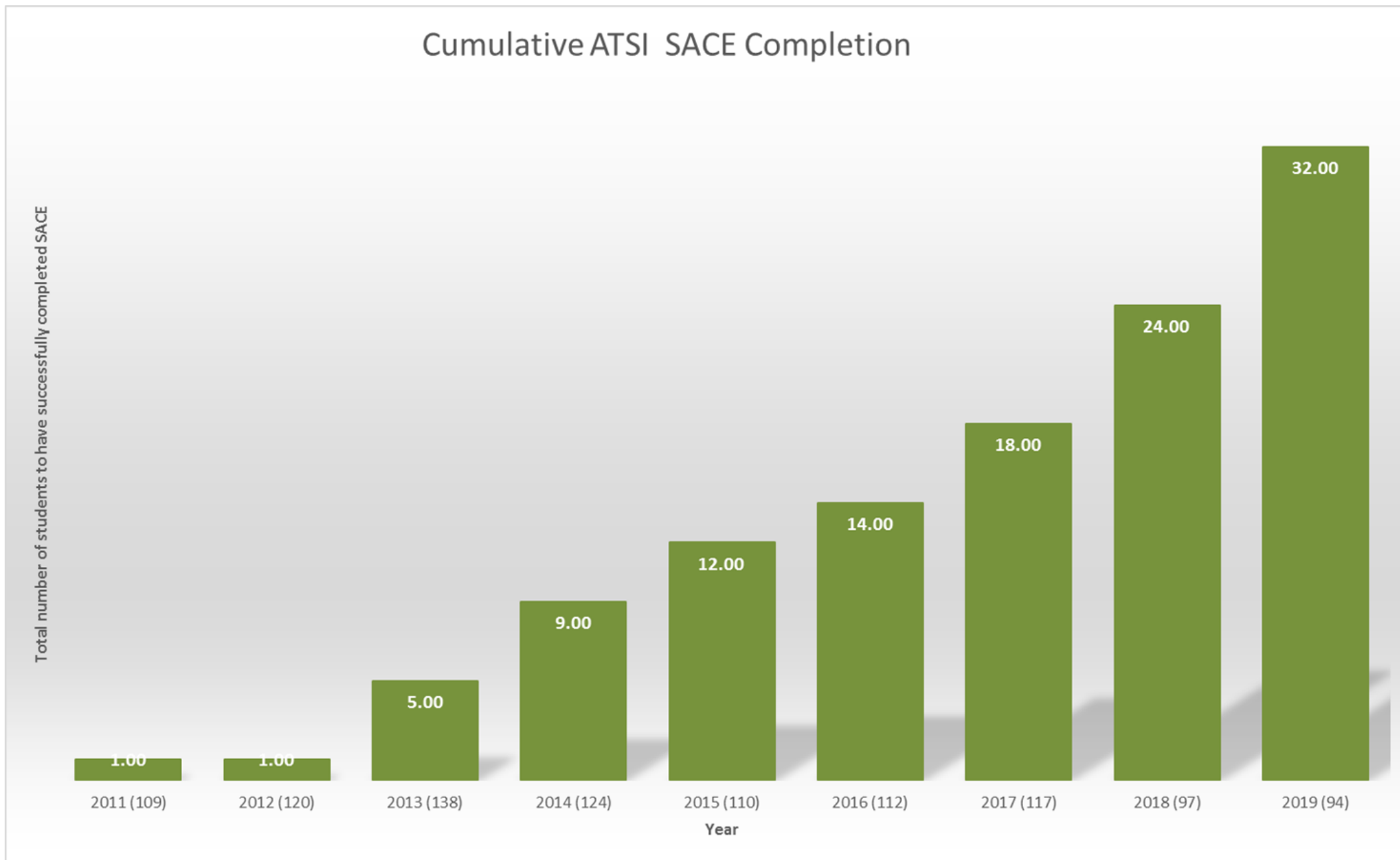

CURRICULUM STRUCTURES

- Week Timetable - 31 lessons per week including 1 skills for success and 5 x 10 minute morning care group.
- Year 12 – 6 line structure, 5 lessons per line
- Year 11 – 7 line structure, 5 lessons for Maths and English, 4 lessons for elective and research project, afternoon study line Thurs and Fri.
- Year 9 & 10 – 7 line structure, 5 lessons for Maths and English, 4 lessons for remaining lines
- Year 7 & 8 – 7 line structure, 5 lessons for Maths and English, 4 for HASS, Science, HPE, Technology, 3 lessons for the Arts, additional skills for success
- Special Classes – care group teacher has classes for 23/31 lessons.



CURRICULUM STRUCTURES

- Middle school classes (7-10) – care group teaches 1-2 lines
- Monday and Friday run single lessons
- Technologies first 3 weeks of program run as ICT capabilities to introduce to school learner management system



MODIFICATIONS FOR 2021 -

- Year 7 care group teachers will teach care groups for 3 lines
- Year 8-9 care group teachers will teach care groups for 2 lines
- Elective Rotations and organisation
 - Arts/Performing Arts (Drama and Music)
 - Technology (Digital/Design) or (Digital/Food/Design)
 - 7 & 8 will remain the same for 2021-2022, year 8 elective choice in 2023?



DEMANDS

- SAASTA Aboriginal Studies/Integrated Learning classes from 10-12
- SAASTA VET
- Special Options classes
- Alternative Learning SACE class
- Combined classes due to low numbers in senior school (10/11, 11/12)
- Soccer Academy (7/8, 8/9, 10-12)
- Part-time staff
- Shorter day Tuesday for extended staff meeting
- Learning Intervention – FLO/Flips, alternate programs
- Project Based Learning and Genius Hour in Middle School



TRADE - OFFS

- Not all staff teach the same number of lessons for 1.0 FTE
- To make up time staff are utilised for reliefs
- Part-time staff share classes (permanent relief), full days off
- Not all subjects get the same time
